The Packing Room



The Packing Room is a flexible event space connected to the IXL Atrium. By day, the room functions as a gallery featuring Tasmanian artworks hand-picked by our Art Curator, Lisa Moroney. Outside of event use, Lisa is based here, serving as a focal point for clients and purveyors of Tasmanian art.

Positioned on the far side of the IXL Atrium, the glass canopy—one of the largest in the Southern Hemisphere—allows a wash of natural light year-round into all adjacent rooms. This innovative space is well suited to cocktail functions, private luncheons, or dinners, and also works seamlessly as a breakout room for conferences.

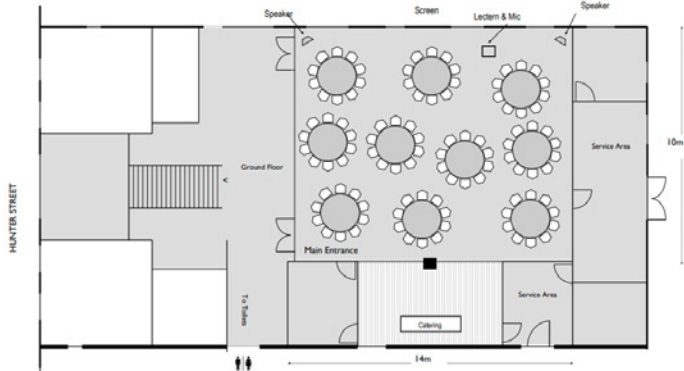
Jones & Co. Room

Whether hosting a corporate function or celebrating a special milestone, the Jones & Co. Room offers a seamless blend of historical charm and contemporary luxury.



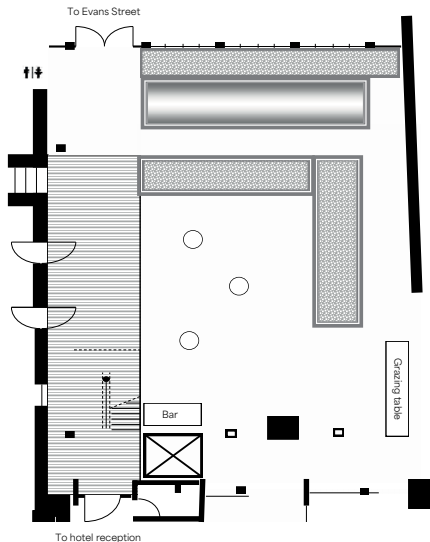

Atrium Courtyard



The Atrium Courtyard is located within one of the Southern Hemisphere’s largest atriums. It is framed by an impressive gnarled piece of Huon Pine—aptly nicknamed “The Monster”—original sandstone walls, and a lush, verdant canopy, creating a stunning natural backdrop.

The courtyard is ideal for smaller, intimate gatherings and cocktail events. It truly comes into its own as a wedding ceremony setting, with natural light filtering through while remaining protected from the elements.



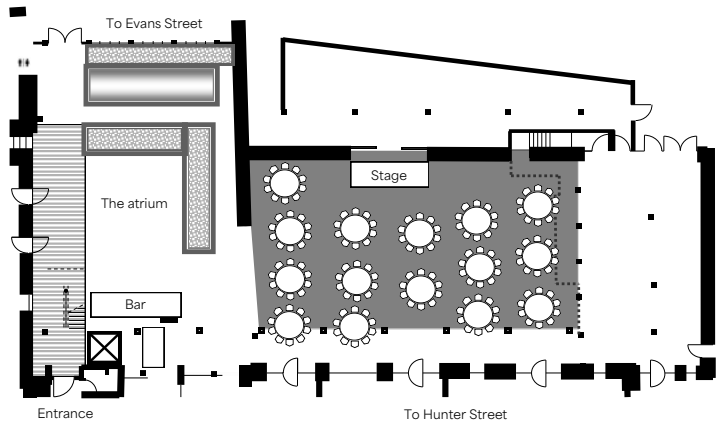

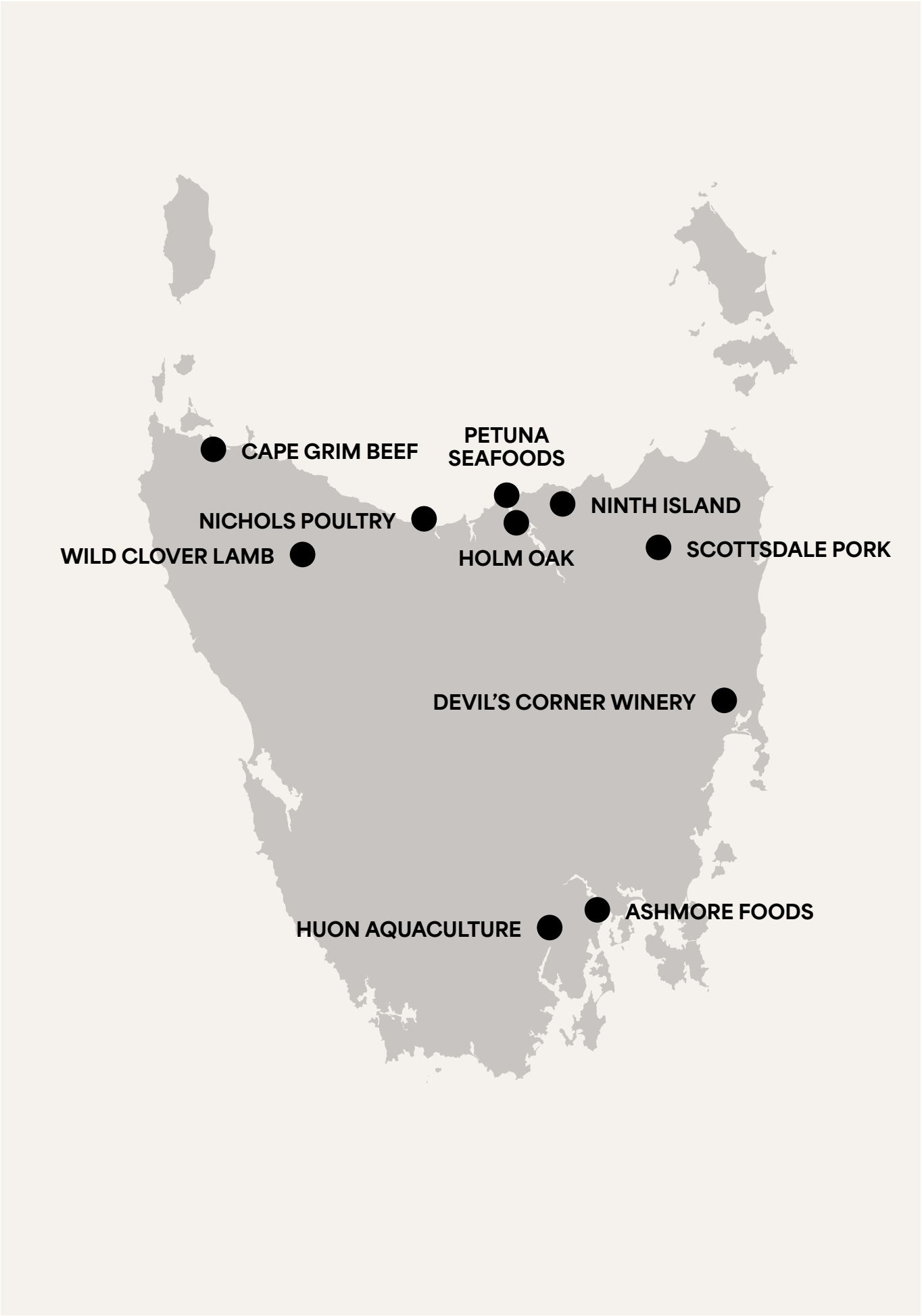
